Golf Outing Rules

1. Team Scramble Contest: Everyone tees off and the best shot is selected. The other players place their ball within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the best ball, and all the players hit from that position. If your best shot lands in the rough or hazard and your team decides on that shot, the ball must be played out of the rough or hazard (sand trap, creek, woods, etc.). The one club length rule applies but must be played out of the rough or hazard. This procedure is followed until the ball is on the green.
2. Putting: When putting, the ball must be placed within one (1) inch of the selected shot, no nearer to the hole. Once the ball is holed out, no further strokes are permitted! **Each player will putt only once per green. The second shot, if necessary, is a gimme (for a 2-putt score).** Team members may stand behind one another to help determine the line of putt.
3. Tee Boxes: Men 60 and over and women will play from the white tees. Men 50-59 will play from the blue tees. Men under 50 will play from the gold tees.
4. Lost Balls: You only have one (1) minute to look for lost balls. Please keep play moving. This will keep it enjoyable for everyone behind you.
5. 3-Some: Please rotate who takes the extra shot on the first shot only. Substitute shots cannot be used in these contests: Closest to the pin (rule 7), Longest drive (rule 8).
6. Slow Play: Keep up with the foursome in front of you. Try to keep your play to a maximum pace of 15 minutes per hole. If your team is having a hard time on a hole pick up and move to the next hole. Max score per hole is double bogey. Thank you for your understanding.
7. Par 3 Holes - Closest to the Pin:
On all Par 3's there will be a Closest-to-the-Pin for Men or Women.

11. Coolers and Alcoholic Beverages: Please, no coolers of beer, pop, or alcoholic beverages may be brought on the course. Beverage carts will come around for your convenience. Water will be available at many holes on the course.
